Silver Division 2: H.I. 12.1 – 20.9.

1 x 18 hole medal round Day 1. 4 players to qualify for match play on Day 2 (Semi-final and final).

(Handicap Parameters for Div 1 and 2 can be adjusted if required to even up the divisions).

Bronze Division is open to H.I. 21.0 to 28.9 inclusive.

The winner will hold the Joan Goldsmith Rose Bowl for twelve months and a prize voucher. 1 x 18-hole medal round Day 1. 4 players to qualify for match play on Day 2 (Semi-final and final).

<u>The Sibyl Bennett Cup</u> is open to H.I. 29.0 to 36.0 inclusive. 18-hole One Day Stableford. To be played on a nominated course.

<u>The Sibyl Browne Vase</u> is open only to players who have taken part in the Championship (including the Sibyl Bennett Cup).

18-hole Stableford to be played on the 2nd day of the Championship meeting. Prizes awarded according to number of entries.

Qualifications. Every competitor for the Championships must be a member of a recognised Isle of Wight Golf Club.

<u>Rules.</u> Those of St Andrews and the Byelaws of the nominated club for the Championships (and those of the nominated club for the Sibyl Bennett Cup).

The committee prefer there to be no caddies on the first day of the Championship but if you do intend to use one in the Match Play, please notify your opponent **giving her time to avail herself of the same option should she desire.** Finalists to select their own caddies.

ALL CADDIES MUST BE MEMBERS OF THE IWLGA

The decision of the IWLGA Committee shall be final on all points.

Ties will be decided on the last 9-6-3-1 holes.

Prizes: A competitor may receive both Scratch and Handicap prizes.

The Competition Secretary must receive entries no later than the date specified on the appropriate entry form.
